WHAT IS THE ACCELERATOR?

THE (Training Home Educators) Accelerator is a six-month, bilingual statewide program for providers who want to grow and improve their family or home-based child care businesses, with the goal of expanding options for families and improving economic opportunity for caregivers.

A collaboration between Growing Up New Mexico, WESST, and Partnership for Community Action (PCA), THE Accelerator centers a dual language approach with training from key experts, peer mentorship, and individualized coaching. Topics include tax support, human resources, financial management, early intervention, child care regulations, quality rating, and use of technology.
