WHAT IS THE ACCELERATOR?

THE (Training Home Educators) Accelerator is a state-wide, bilingual program for providers who want to grow and improve their family/home-based child care business. The six-month, intensive training helps increase the supply of quality child care for families and improves economic opportunities for caregivers.

A collaboration between Growing Up New Mexico, WESST, and Partnership for Community Action (PCA), THE Accelerator provides training from key experts, peer mentorship, and individualized coaching. Topics include tax support, human resources, financial management, early intervention, child care regulations, quality rating, and use of technology.



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
